

The following information is based on 2 adults and 2 children (8 and 10 years old). Kona folks are closer to the airport, but have a farther drive to the harbor; Waimea and North Kohala folks are closer to the harbor, but have a farther drive to the airport, so it's basically a wash. On the K.H. departure for the HNL trip, there is a midnight departure, which would give HSF passengers more time on Oahu, but I truly believe most parents would not choose that trip due to departure and arrival times. This is also true for the Maui trip. It was difficult to decide if one would want to spend 13 hours in transit; thereby getting more time on Maui, but arriving at 3 a.m., or spending the night on Oahu (possibly having to pay for a hotel) and having less time on Maui. I chose the former, although admittedly, there might be those who would like to spend a night on Oahu and then go to Maui and stay from 11 a.m. and depart at 11:30 p.m. On the Maui return trip, HSF passengers would get more time on Maui if they take the 11:00 p.m. departure from OGG on Sunday, but I feel pretty confident that most parents would not choose a 14 hr. trip from Kahului to Kawaihae (7 of which are spent in HNL) and having their children miss a day of school, since the arrival is Monday at 1:00 p.m.
