**Smooth Sailing** - Our schedules and port facilities are designed to address traffic issues.

**It's No Fluke** - Our Whale Avoidance Policy is stricter than federal regulations.

Federal law dictates that vessels stay at least 100 yds. away from whales. Hawaii Superferry's Whale Avoidance Policy dictates the ferry will stay 500 yds. from whales. What protocols does Hawaii Superferry have in place in the event a whale surfaces within either the 100 yd. or 500 yd. restricted areas?

It's less than 5 months from the scheduled start of service. What conditions are in place NOW to help prevent invasive species from being transported between islands?

**No Free Rides** - We're working with Hawaii Department of Agriculture to help prevent invasive species from hitching a ride.
